

Rasuwa-Bhotekoshi Flood: Search, Rescue and Relief Response

Situation Report # 13



Date: 14 September 2026 Time: 07:00PM

This report has been prepared by the NDRRMA based on information received from DAO and District/National Emergency Operation Centers. It summarizes the response actions undertaken for search, rescue, and relief management following the Rasuwa-Bhotekoshi flood situation.

Highlights

- Road connectivity has been restored in accessible areas to supply relief materials, while basic relief materials have been provided via helicopters to remote and severely affected regions.
- A total of 2,418 affected individuals are currently taking shelter across 33 holding centers in the flood-affected districts, including 825 individuals in 9 holding centers in Rasuwa district, 1,499 individuals in 22 holding centers in Nuwakot district, and 94 individuals in 2 holding centers in Dhading district.
- The assessments of potential land sites suitable for constructing temporary shelters across various locations in Nuwakot (Bidur Municipality, Belkotgadhi), Dhading (Galchi, Gajuri), and Rasuwa have been completed.
- A total of 341 patients received treatment across 19 health facilities, of whom 278 have been discharged, 27 remain under treatment, 32 were referred to other hospitals, and 4 individuals passed away during treatment.
- 38 health centers have been operationalized across 4 districts, providing emergency healthcare services to 7,707 individuals, psychosocial support to 427 individuals, and free ambulance services to 26 individuals, while response operations continue seamlessly in affected areas through 6 Emergency Medical Teams (EMT) and 7 forensic teams.
- In flood-affected areas, emergency medical care and psychosocial counseling for injured students and teachers have been intensified, alongside efforts to rehabilitate 18 damaged schools, maintain educational continuity for 9,430 students, set up temporary learning centers, and implement a NPR 10.5 Crore early recovery plan.



- Regular communication channels have established from the Situation Room of the NDRRMA, with each local government and ward on a daily basis to prepare municipality-level "Report Cards" capturing the current situation and identified needs.
- Daily meetings of the Monsoon Response Command Post and briefing sessions of the Mobilization Team are being conducted to review the responsibilities assigned under the respective Terms of Reference (ToR), progress against the assigned responsibilities, emerging issues and challenges, and efforts undertaken to address them.

Search and Rescue Operations

Update: Ongoing Search and rescue operations at different hydropower projects sites.

Project Name	Actions Taken
Rasuwadgaadi Hydropower Project (120 MW)	- Heavy equipment is required to continue search and rescue operations; however, transportation remains difficult due to challenging geographical conditions. - A joint team comprising CQRT and project representatives successfully reached the powerhouse, transformer room, and control room. - Search and rescue operations are ongoing.
Langtang Hydropower Project (20 MW)	- Soil and boulders were found blocking an entrance measuring approximately 10 meters in length, 3 feet in width, and 4 feet in height leading to the other side from the outlet route, and clearance work is currently underway. - A joint team comprising the Nepali Army and the Chinese DART Team entered approximately 170 meters into the project tunnel and conducted a search using a thermal drone but found nothing. - Search and rescue operations are ongoing.
Chilime Hydropower Project (22 MW)	- Track construction has been completed to transport heavy equipment to the Chilime Hydropower Project tunnel. - Debris clearing operations have progressed up to approximately 90 meters inside. - Due to water flowing out from inside, the level of muddy slurry has receded, creating an overhead clearance of approximately 1.5 to 2 feet. Entry into the tunnel is currently being carried out using ropes until the water can be pumped out - Search and rescue operations are ongoing.
Upper Trishuli-1 Hydropower Project (216 MW)	- Water is currently gushing out from the Audit-3 tunnel, increasing operational risks for further entry into the tunnel. - A joint team comprising 5 Nepali Army personnel and project representatives conducted a search up to 200 meters inside the Audit-1 tunnel at Hakubesi, but found no traces/individuals. - Search and rescue operations using thermal drones are actively underway at Audit-3 of the Upper Trishuli-1 Hydropower Project.
Trishuli 3A Hydropower Project (60 MW)	- Due to continuous heavy rainfall, landslides around the entrance to the Trishuli 3A Hydropower Project powerhouse tunnel blocked the intake mouth, and manual clearance of the entrance is currently underway. - Search operations are actively ongoing inside the tunnel and across the powerhouse area.
Trishuli 3B Hydropower Project (37 MW)	- Search operations are ongoing at deep excavation levels around the project's residential/housing quarters. Although the current river surface elevation is at 653 meters above sea level, no building structures were located even after excavating down to a depth/elevation of 651 meters. - Upon excavating continuously to a depth of approximately 2 meters below the riverbed/river surface level, the foundation of the project office building was discovered; however, no structural remnants of the residential compound (Buildings A1, A2, B1, B2, and D) were found. - Excavation work is currently underway at the site of the project's powerhouse.

DNA Sample Collection and Forensic Examination

- A total of 3,139 DNA samples has been collected, comprising 1,286 from the bodies of the deceased and 1,853 from relatives. While relatives' samples were gathered from 62 locations nationwide, 59% were collected from the Kathmandu Valley alone.
- A total of 1,661 samples were received by the Nepal Police Central Forensic Science Laboratory (NPCFSL) and 1,496 samples by the National Forensic Science Laboratory (Khumaltar) for testing.
- Forensic expert teams deployed from India, South Korea, Singapore, China, and the United States have initiated testing procedures for 1,205 blood samples and 202 bone/tooth samples.

Sectoral Deployment and Public Awareness

- Search, rescue, drone and K9 deployments, as well as relief and rehabilitation management operations, have been completed along a 218 km river corridor covering 8 affected districts from Timure to Triveni.
- A total of 196 awareness programs have been conducted across 10 affected districts, engaging

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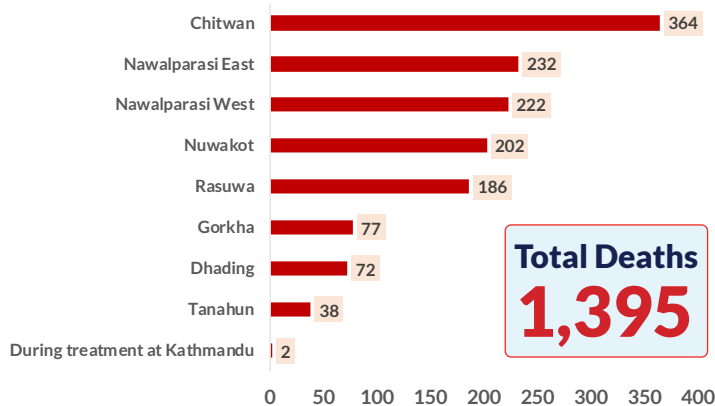

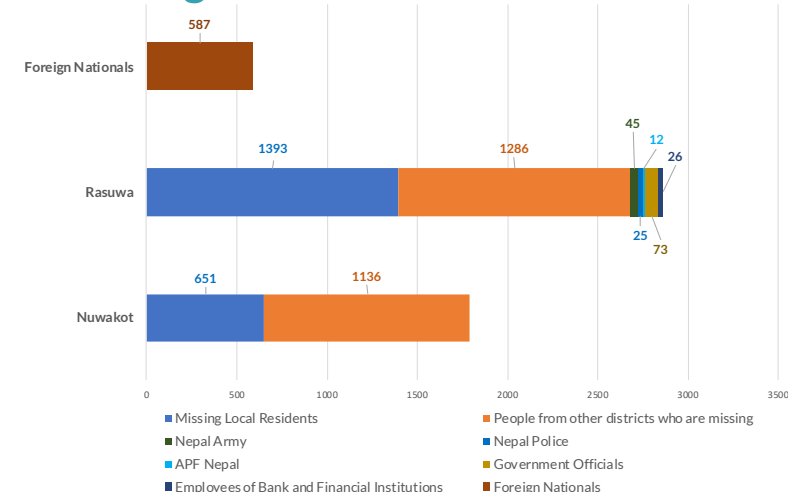

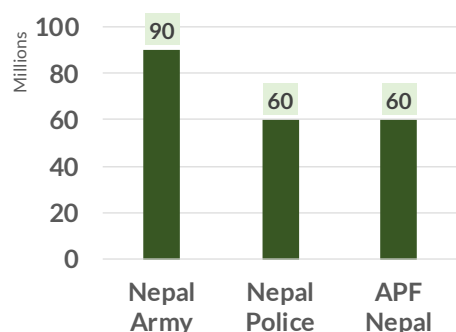
Relief Supplies

- Food and non-food relief materials continuously dispatched to affected districts by road and air; details recorded in the Authority's Setu App.
- Continued support from government/non-government agencies, private, development partners, civil society, and other stakeholders.

Bridge

An Acrow bridge has been installed and brought into operation at Devighat, Nuwakot.

Additional Budget for Search and Rescue Equipment



Additional Cash support from Government of Nepal

- For families unwilling to stay in holding centers, a monthly allowance for accommodation and livelihood will be provided until alternative housing is arranged, for a maximum period of six months, at a rate of NPR. 15,000 per family (for up to four members) plus an additional NPR. 2,000 per member for any members exceeding that number.

Criminal Investigation and Law Enforcement

- In Narayangadh, 2 individuals were taken into custody for stealing valuables from deceased bodies in Dhading, 29 individuals were arrested for breaking open a flood-swept safe and looting cash (recovering NPR 9,268,505); and 1 individual was apprehended for concealing gold jewelry.
- One individual was arrested for fraudulent fundraising under the guise of a relief fund, and 1 individual was detained for inciting racial/ethnic hatred on social media. Furthermore, 173 posts disrupting social harmony across digital media were flagged, and 88 pieces of content have been removed.

Relief Distribution

- Emergency relief materials were distributed with a primary focus on search and rescue operations amid severe food shortages and complete communication blackouts in the affected areas.
- Strategic plans are in place to ensure continuous airlifting of relief supplies to remote regions via helicopters, strengthen storage management at relief collection hubs, implement standardized distribution protocols through victim classification, and restore the local economy.

Food Relief Distribution and Stock Details

- Rice: Out of a total 589,000 kg, 193,000 kg has been allocated to Nuwakot (remaining stock: 35,852 kg), 207,000 kg to Dhading (remaining stock: 21,028 kg), and 99,900 kg to Rasuwa (remaining stock: 78,910 kg).
- Lentils (Pulses): Out of a total of 190,000 kg, 50,000 kg has been distributed in Nuwakot, 50,000 kg in Dhading, and 27,000 kg in Rasuwa, with the remaining quantities kept in stock.
- Cooking Oil and Salt: A total of 45,000 liters of cooking oil and 75,000 kg of salt have been distributed based on priority across all three affected districts (Nuwakot, Dhading, and Rasuwa), with the remaining stock safely stored.

Power and Fuel Supply

Fuel Supply

- A stock of 15,000 liters of aviation fuel is available at the Nuwakot Barracks, with an additional 145,000 liters supplied today.
- To address high demand received from various locations, 150 LP gas cylinders have been dispatched to the District Administration Office, Rasuwa as relief; however, fulfilling the total gas demand remains challenging.

Restoration of Electricity Supply

- Dhading: Electricity supply has been fully restored across the district. To resolve low-voltage issues, the Jaharsab Substation was brought into operation yesterday.
- Nuwakot: Electricity transmission from Chapali and Balaju in Kathmandu has restored power across all parts of the district, except in the flood-affected areas of Betrawati.
 - Technical teams are currently conducting studies to operationalize the Devighat Substation.
 - A stabilizer was installed to operate the Bidur Water Supply pumps, and a 3.36 kW solar power system was installed at Trishuli Hospital.
- Rasuwa: Power supply has been restored to approximately 80% of households.
 - Initiatives are underway through the District Administration Office to secure local consensus for extending electricity to Ward No. 3 from the 100 kW Langtang Micro-Hydro project located in Gosaikunda Rural Municipality, Ward No. 4.

Alternative Energy and Transport Coordination

- Alternative Solar Systems: Plans are in place to provide power through household and institutional solar systems in remote areas of Rasuwa where grid electricity restoration will take time.

Roads, Bridges, and Transportation

Status of Major Highways and Track Opening Operations

- Prithvi Highway: Clearing of landslides and continuous maintenance operations are ongoing to keep the Krishnabhir, Parewa Bhir, and Sheetal Bazar road sections operational.
- Bidur-Betrawati Section: Out of the total 10 km length, 9.2 km of the road has been cleared. As the remaining 0.8 km was completely washed away, intensive operations are underway to cut through 0.5 km of hard rock to open a new track and apply gravel..

Alternative Routes and Transport Operations

- Alternative Routes Connecting Kathmandu: Alternative routes entering Kathmandu via Abukhaireni – 12 Kilo – Masanethanti – Arughat – Salyantar – Dhadingbesi (Mastar/Benighat) have been operationalized for vehicles coming from Kaski, Lamjung, Tanahun, and Gorkha.
- Alternative to Devighat Bridge: Following damage to the Tadi River bridge, traffic movement has been resumed via the Pipaltar – Pasang Lhamu Highway – Niranjana – Baghkhori – Deurali – Kolputar section.
- Trans-Trishuli Corridor Network: Due to damage to bridges across the Trishuli River, the right-bank road operating through Galchhi – Kalleritar – Darshantar – Chhatrekhol to Trishuli Bazar has been brought into service.
- Rasuwa Access Route: With the Trishuli-Betrawati section obstructed, vehicular movement is being maintained through repairs undertaken by the Road Division along the Dhikure (Mid-Hill Highway) – Phedibesi – Chogate – Bore Bhanjyang – Bhorle – Jibjibe – Bogatitar (Pasang Lhamu Highway) route.

Bailey Bridge Installation

- Devighat (Tadi River): Installation of the Bailey bridge has been fully completed.
- Betrawati (Phalakhu Khola): Foundation construction for the Bailey bridge assembly has commenced.

Communication Sector

- Nepal Telecom: Out of 120 BTS towers, 117 are currently operational.
- Ncell: Out of 78 BTS towers, 76 are currently operational.
- Services remain obstructed at Chilime Khola, Trishuli 3B, and Uttargaya-1 (Tiru) due to power supply shortages.
- Fuel for backup generators is currently being supplied via air transport to restore and sustain telecommunication services.

Health Sector

Emergency Medical Teams (EMT)

- A total of 34 EMT teams have been deployed to date, of which 28 have demobilized upon completing their missions and 6 teams remain active in the field (Armed Police Force, Nepal: 5; E-Piners Nepal: 1).
- A workforce of 149 medical personnel has provided health services to 7,707 individuals overall, including 135 individuals served in the last 24 hours.
- Continuous coordination is maintained through designated contact points at holding centers, and 4 additional teams have been kept on standby.

Holding Center Management

- Over the last 24 hours, health and psychosocial services were provided to 519 affected individuals.

Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS)

- A total of 137 teams comprising 137 personnel, including psychiatrists (field deployment: 135; helpline support: 17), have been mobilized.
- A total of 427 individuals received mental health and psychosocial counseling services in the last 24 hours.

Ambulance and Casualty Transport Services

- Ambulance dispatch via the 102-emergency hotline service has been arranged for 3 holding centers in Kathmandu (Mustang Gumba, Yellow Gumba, and Buddha Sangh).
- Armed Police Force ambulances and a Mass Casualty Vehicle have been stationed on standby at Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA) for patient transfers.
- A total of 26 individuals have utilized the free ambulance service operated through the Nepal Red Cross Society, Nuwakot Chapter.
- Operational readiness has been maintained at the Emergency Clinic in Bidur-5 with 2 ambulances and 3 drivers (including 2 trained personnel).

Education Sector

Damage Status

- Physical damage has been recorded across 18 educational institutions, including 13 fully damaged and 5 partially damaged facilities.
- Fully destroyed 45 school buildings and 268 classrooms. Following the incident, 24 teachers and 500 students remain missing.
- Learning continuity for 9,430 students has been impacted, with 1,372 students currently displaced.
- A total of 25 schools are presently being utilized as emergency temporary shelters.

Response and Progress to Date

- All 6 affected educational institutions in Dhading District have resumed operations.

- Out of 68 required Temporary Learning Centers (TLCs), 13 have been established to date (each with a capacity for 30 students).
- Distribution of relief kits includes 860 Student Kits, 27 School Kits, and 13 Early Childhood Educational Development (ECED) Kits (each serving 30 students).
- The Bagmati Province Government plans to accommodate 200 residential students at the Kshetrapal Secondary School hostel in Likhu, while Uttargaya Rural Municipality (Rasuwa) plans to board 250 students at Neelakantha Secondary School.

Key Targets of the Immediate Response Plan

- Establish 46 additional TLCs, 82 temporary toilets, and restore 55 water supplies restoration.
- Provide Student Kits to 9,430 affected students, Emergency Support Kits to 1,372 displaced students, and textbooks to 3,232 students, while completing debris removal, cleaning, and disinfection across 20 school sites.
- Restore or supply 194 desktop computers and 144 laptops, alongside arranging 4,561 sets of classroom furniture.
- Conduct weekly psychosocial counseling and child safeguarding sessions across all affected schools for a duration of 3 months.

Shelter and Camp Management Sector

- Design prototypes and cost estimates have been prepared for 1-room, 2-room, and 3/4-room Model temporary shelters for affected households.
- 3 coordination meetings were convened with Shelter Cluster partner agencies, securing participation from over 11 humanitarian organizations alongside resource mapping.

Phased Action Plan: Progress Status

- Phase 1 (Holding Center Management): Provisioning of essential relief supplies and daily consumables across active holding centers remains ongoing.
- Phase 2 (Site Identification and Risk Assessment): Identification of safe land plots is underway through Rapid Multi-Hazard Assessments for potential camp management.
- Phase 3 (Structured Camp Establishment – Next 2 Weeks): Operations are progressing to establish structured camps equipped with Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH), electricity, healthcare, security, and access roads across identified locations. Standards have been fixed at a minimum of 15 liters of safe drinking water per person per day and 1 toilet/washroom facility per 20 individuals (with a 3:1 female-to-male ratio).
- Phase 4 (Transitional Shelter Construction – Next 4 to 10 Weeks): Construction of transitional shelters utilizing prefabricated units and locally sourced materials will be executed across structured camps and designated sites.
